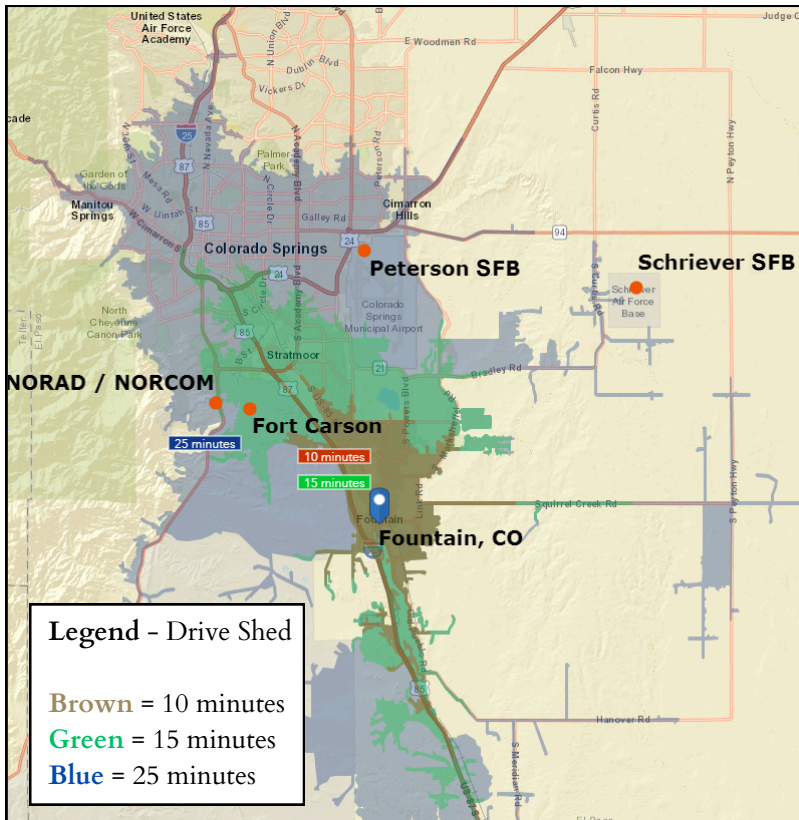

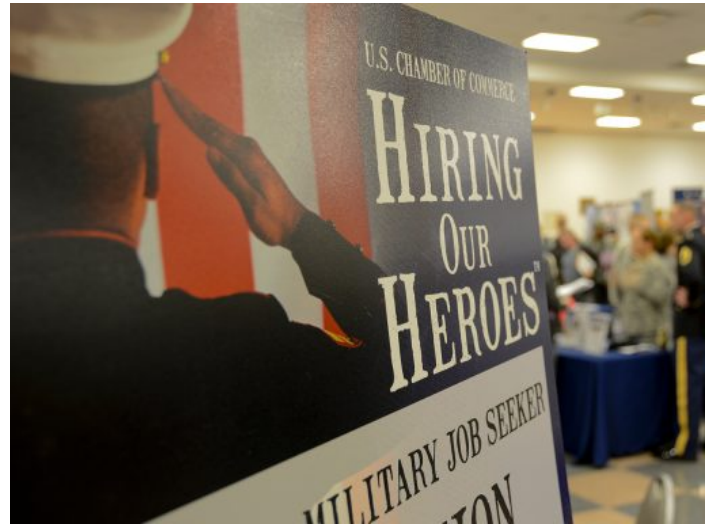

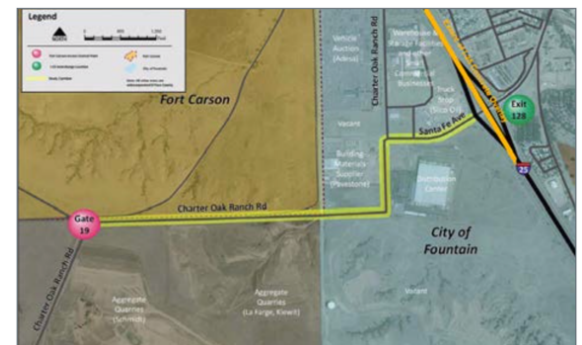

- ★ Fort Carson - Potential benefactor of \$2.8M Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvement Program (CRISI) funding for the Southern Colorado Rail Park Project; City of Fountain partnership
- ★ Peterson Space Force Base - Potential benefactor of 2024 Federal Defense Community Infrastructure Program funds (allocation amount TBD), North Gate access safety improvements
- ★ Fort Carson / Peterson-Schriever - Benefactor of \$161M Military Access, Mobility & Safety Improvement Project (MAMSIP), Four project components; CDOT and El Paso County partnerships
